Annual membership fee of \$200 provided by the Friends

Each paper pass admits 2 adults and 2 children per car at 50% off. Admission fee with pass: \$9 per adult, \$7 for children, seniors & college students. Children under 2 are admitted free. Active military personnel and spouses receive 2 for 1 admission with ID. Hours: Tuesday through Saturday: 10 a.m.-5 p.m. Sunday: 12 noon-5 p.m. Closed: Mondays, New Year's Day, Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day. GO PASS

Passes provided by the Friends

Each single use pass admits 2 adults and children under 18 to 116 different venues that are part of The Trustees, a MA conservation and preservation land trust. Admission fee with the pass is equivalent to the price of admission for a Trustee Family level membership. Venues include beaches, farms and woodlands, historic homes, urban gardens and more. MASSACHUSETTS STATE PARKS PASS

2 Passes provided by MDCR (Jan.-Dec.)

2 passes, each provides free admission for 1 passenger vehicle any day of the week. The pass must be displayed in the vehicle at all times while visiting a Mass. State Park facility where parking fees are charged. Daily parking fees without the pass are between \$3-\$14/day. Please lock your vehicle to prevent theft of the pass. Not valid for camping. Each single use paper pass admits 2 people at \$10.00 each. Children 6 and under: free. Children 7-17 are free during weekdays after 3 pm. and weekends. Hours: Open Mon. & Tues. 10 a.m.-5 p.m., Wed. through Fri. 10 a.m.-10 p.m., Saturday and Sunday 10 a.m.-5 p.m. Closed: New Year's Day, Patriot's Day, July 4, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Seven passes, each admits 4 individuals, at a \$4.00 discount. Admission fee with pass: \$32.99/adult; \$27.99/senior; \$26.99/youth (13-17); \$22.99/child (3-12); under 2: free. Hours: Jan. & Feb: 10 a.m.-4:50 p.m.; March: 9 a.m.-4:50 p.m.; April-Labor Day: 9 a.m. – 5:50 p.m.; Sept. 6-Nov.: 9 a.m.-4:50 p.m.; Dec: 10 a.m.-4:50 p.m. Website: www.mysticaquarium.org Admission doors close one hour prior to aquarium closing. Closed: Thanksgiving and Christmas.
