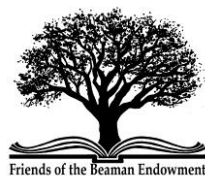

MISSION

The Beaman Memorial Public Library is the jewel of West Boylston; its stately building graces the center of our town. The dedicated library staff provides for the information needs of our citizens - young and old -through the library's varied collections within its walls. More than that, the library serves as the focal point of our community by providing meeting spaces for town organizations and by offering special programs for children, teens, and adults. It is the center for lifelong learning in West Boylston and used by many in our neighboring communities.

HISTORY

The public library was established in West Boylston in 1878 as the result of a bequest from David Lee Child. Library service continued to evolve over the next three decades in response to the changing community. In 1911, through a generous donation by George Calvin Rice, Beaman Memorial Public Library was built.

In 1999, with a \$1 million grant from the State and generous local funding of \$1.34 million, the building was renovated and expanded. The community further raised \$200,000 to purchase furnishings and shelving for the new space. The vision of George Calvin Rice has been translated into a modern facility that has barrier-free access, provides room for future growth, accommodates new technologies, and offers the public a comfortable and welcoming library.
