Non-residents may borrow passes on the day of use if there is a pass available for that day. All passes must be returned to Beaman Library at the end of their use. A fine of \$5.00 will be added to your account if a pass is returned late. No more than 2 different venue passes may be reserved or used by a family or individual at a time.

DAVIS FARMLAND

Annual membership fee of \$399 provided by the Friends

ECOTARIUM

Annual membership fee of \$250 provided by the Friends

GO PASS

Annual membership fee of \$350 provided by the Friends
Each single use pass admits 2 adults and children under 18 to 116 different venues that are part of The Trustees, a Massachusetts conservation and preservation land trust. Admission fee with the pass is equivalent to the price of admission for a Trustee Family level membership. Venues include beaches, farms and woodlands, historic homes, urban gardens and more. MASSACHUSETTS STATE PARKS PASS

2 passes provided by MDCR;
2 passes valued at \$120 provided by the Friends
Each pass provides free admission for 1 passenger vehicle any day of the week. The pass must be always displayed in the vehicle while visiting a Massachusetts State Park facility where parking fees are charged. Please lock your vehicle to prevent theft of the pass.
